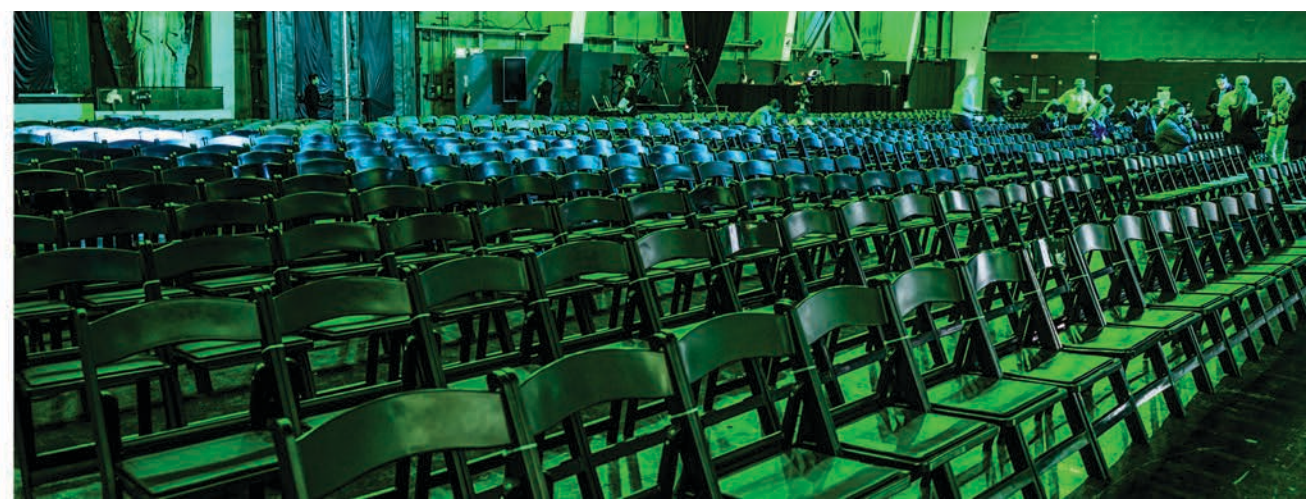
ICONIC + SPACIOUS + INSPIRING

Largely considered one of the Nation's most iconic landmarks, **The Palace of Fine Arts** was originally designed by Bernard Maybeck for the 1915 Panama Pacific Exposition. An expansive open mezzanine, theater space and multiple breakout rooms stretch across more than 140,000 square feet of highly versatile interior space. The Palace can be found in the Marina District, with an unbeatable view of the Golden Gate Bridge.
